Because our numbers are so small and we have many students that come here from Guatemala and also open enrollment, we have a great deal of students moving in and out of our district, which reflects on our graduation rates. We have 11% of our graduates "unknown" in 2022, so our rate was 72% with and 11% continuing and 5% drop out.
